



10/20/07—The Trailblazers cut a wide path to Winston Salem at the Fourth /annual “More Than Conquerors” State Homeschool Tournament! In their first appearance at the state tourney, in the second game of the day, the High School Girls volleyball team won the five game match against The Hawks from Forsyth County and was named NCHEAC Varsity Volleyball State Champions! Coach Glenna Toney was faced with additional obstacles when two players became ill at the last minute and were unable to participate. The team rallied and all players contributed, especially All Tournament selection Glenn Gibson. Joining her on the All Tournament team were Brittani Taylor and Marissa Moraga. The Middle School Girls coached by Brenda Watt, on court number two, held their own by narrowly losing to the #1 seed, the Euroclydon Storm from Orange County; they came together to take third place in the tournament by soundly defeating The Crusaders of Fayetteville. This team played excellent volleyball and was encouraged by Jessi Phillips, setter, who was named to the All Tournament team. Outdoors, the soccer field was ablaze with WCAA activity coached by Greg Toney and Scott Brinkerhoff. In their first game, the boys of WNC defeated Fayetteville 2-1. The team showed great strength and heart when they went on to the field again, in less than two hours, to play the defending state champions from Forsyth County, with narrow defeat of 3-1! This Trailblazers team also returns to the west with an admirable third place finish and All Tournament honors going to Matt Tokay and Andrew Clark.

With one state title and two third place finishes, Coach Glenna Toney was correct when she commented, “They know The Trailblazers have been here!”
